LEGAL YEAR-ROUND (DE-REGULATED NOVELTIES)

- ✓ Sparklers
- ✓ Smoke devices
- ✓ Snappers
- ✓ Party poppers

These novelty items are legal to possess and use year-round in Arizona.



LEGAL DURING DESIGNATED SALES/USE PERIODS*

(NON-AERIAL CONSUMER FIREWORKS ONLY)

- ✓ Ground spinners
- ✓ Ground-based sparkling devices
- ✓ Sparkling wheel devices
- ✓ Ground fountains
- ✓ Consumer ground devices containing up to 500 grams of pyrotechnic composition

**Only during periods authorized by Arizona law and subject to local restrictions.*



ALWAYS ILLEGAL FOR CONSUMER USE

- ✗ Firecrackers
- ✗ Bottle rockets
- ✗ Roman candles
- ✗ Reloadable shells
- ✗ Aerial shells
- ✗ Mortars
- ✗ Any device that explodes
- ✗ Any device that leaves the ground



FIREWORKS ARE FIRE.

Each year in the United States, fireworks cause:

- More than **31,000** reported fires annually
- Approximately **7,400** injuries treated in emergency rooms around July 4th
- Burns account for **38%** of those injuries
- Children younger than 15 account for **28%** of estimated fireworks injuries
- Sparklers account for **29%** of fireworks injuries among children under age 5

Leave the fireworks to the professionals.



COMMERCIAL DISPLAYS ONLY

Aerial fireworks displays are only legal when conducted under permit by licensed professional operators.



STAY ALERT. STAY SAFE. LEAVE THE FIREWORKS TO THE PROFESSIONALS.
